

PREPARING TWO-DIMENSIONAL ARTWORK FOR DISPLAY:

- Choose good quality frames and prepare work for hanging as follows:
- Equip all work with “d-ring” hardware (also called strap hangers) **exactly** the same distance down **from the top** of the piece, on each side. The recommended distance is 1/4 to 1/3 the length of your frame. Locate hardware near the exterior edges of the frame making sure it is not visible from the front of the piece. If you have two or more frames of the same size, place d-rings the same distance down from the top of the frame and the same distance in from the edge on all similarly sized pieces. D-rings can be attached vertically or horizontally, but not at an angle. Do not use screw eyes because they can pull out easily and they prevent the frame from laying flush against the wall.
- Attach wire, but do not leave a lot of slack; neither the hook nor the wire must show above the top of the frame. Braided frame wire will stretch.
