Information about the Sunday, June 13 Congregational Meeting to Vote on the Joint Development and Air Rights Proposal

- By rule of the Book of Order, only members of the congregation will be eligible to vote and only those members present at the congregational meeting may vote. There will be no absentee or proxy voting. This rule honors that the Holy Spirit's presence is called into our midst when we are a gathered community and that no decision should be made by the faithful outside that gathered community.
- Upon registering *(see page 1)*, members will receive a wristband permitting them to enter the sanctuary floor for the meeting. Guests will be directed to the balconies and Anderson Hall as space permits.
- John Buchanan will moderate the meeting; Janet Wilson of the Presbytery of Chicago has been invited as parliamentarian.
- Child care will be available in Westminster House during the meeting.

Procedures Recommended by the Congregational Meeting Committee Established by the Session

- Discussion will be in the format used by Presbyterian governing bodies: There will be a time limit for discussion, with the ability to extend time by motion of the floor. Speakers from the floor will present at pro or con microphones and will be asked to introduce themselves. There will be a two-minute time limit for each comment, and comments will alternate between pro and con speakers.
- The vote will be by written ballot. The votes will be counted and announced at the meeting. Our auditors will monitor the count.
